

Rule 15 Plurals



The Golden Rules:

If a word ends in a consonant followed by a 'y', it changes to 'ies' in the plural

- If a word ends in s, x, sh or ch, then you add 'es' in the plural
- If a word ends in f, it changes to 'ves' in the plural



Watch out:

Roof - roofs Chief - chiefs
