

<u>Rule 21</u> Cial or tial?



The Golden Rules:

- Use 'cial' for words where the stem ends in a vowel e.g. special, artificial, social.
- Use 'tial' after a word where the stem ends in a consonant e.g. confidential, essential.



Watch out:

Spatial, initial, palatial Provincial, financial, commercial
